Teachers have developed guidelines that address the grading of daily homework ensuring the assignments equal 10% of a student's cumulative grade

Late Work

If you miss class or need more time to meet a deadline it is the student's responsibility to communicate concerns to the teacher. Assignments not turned in will earn an E. All assignments can be turned in before the close of the 9-weeks for a late grade. Dates are outlined below with sketchbook checks. After and before school times can be scheduled as well as working lunches. If an extenuating circumstance occurs please inform the teacher to work out details.

Explanation of Zeroes

Teachers will refrain from initially assigning zeroes and make every effort to hold the student accountable. If an assignment is not turned in by the end of the quarter, the grade will earn a zero.

Reassessment

Teachers have developed guidelines that address reassessments ensuring any student who receives a failing grade on a summative assessment be given an opportunity for reassessment. Students who are allowed to take a reassessment, will not earn a grade higher than 64%.

Make-up Work

All make-up work will be provided for excused and unexcused absences. It is the student's responsibility to get their make-up work from the teacher upon their return to school.

Extra Credit

Extra credit is not available in the practical arts' courses.
