Homework

Late Work

All assignments can be turned in before the close of the 9-weeks for a late grade. Dates are outlined below with sketchbook checks. After and before school times can be scheduled as well as working lunches. If an extenuating circumstance occurs please inform the teacher to work out details.

Explanation of Zeroes

Teachers will refrain from initially assigning zeroes and make every effort to hold the student accountable. If an assignment is not turned in by the end of the quarter, the grade will earn a zero.

Reassessment

Teachers have developed guidelines that address reassessments ensuring any student who receives a failing grade on a summative assessment be given an opportunity for reassessment. Students who are allowed to take a reassessment, will not earn a grade higher than 64%.

Make-up Work

It is the student's responsibility to inquire and attain any materials he/she missed. Students should speak with me before the bell rings, in the last 5 minutes of class or after school. I strongly encourage students to exchange contact information with a reliable classmate who can report about class if needed. Students can access make up handouts in a labeled folder located in the classroom.
